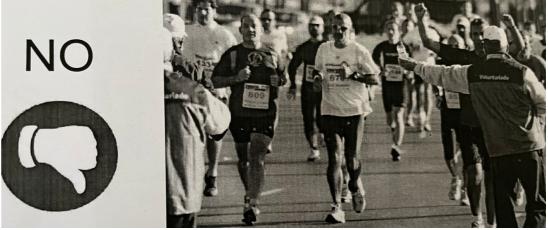
#### **APPEALS and PROTESTS**

### **REFRESHMENTS**

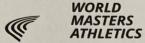
